Re: ADEM 27 Challenge

Dear Chris,

I am writing to challenge the results of the Saturday, January 10, 2015 Assembly District Election Meetings for AD 27.

There is evidence that some of the participants were not properly registered in AD 27 or perhaps not eligible to vote. While the convener, Tony Alexander, did challenge at least one participant at the time of the ADEM, it appears there was an unusual spike of voters who were clearly not registered to vote in AD-27.

While I understand that ADEM voting is secret and individual ballots are anonymous, I do believe that it would be important to verify the registration status of each participant by reviewing the sign-in envelopes used at the AD 27 ADEM and verifying the registration status of each participant. Specifically, it appears that some participants listed an AD 27 household as their registration address though they do not live in AD 27.

In my view, the very integrity of the process has been compromised. Therefore, I believe that the only way to rectify the situation would be to negate the outcome of the election, and hold a new election with CA Democratic Party personnel serving as monitors in order to ensure that the fraud that took place on January 10th does not occur again.
