1 Summary of Incident

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3 On May 10, 2016 at approximately 1530 hours, I received information from San Jose CHP Lieutenant Scot
4 Loetscher #15076 that there was suspicious activity on Juliet Ave south of Rosemar Ave in the City of San
5 Jose. The suspicious activity was occurring near the residence of State Assemblymember Nora Campos. I
6 responded from the San Jose CHP office and arrived at the incident area at approximately 1545 hours.
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8 I was contacted by witness Darren Hampton in front of [REDACTED] Hampton told me that he observed
9 two adult men in and about a maroon Ford Fusion parked across the street from his house. Hampton
10 approached the two men and asked if he could help. One of the men asked which house belonged to Nora
11 Campos. Hampton told them to contact Campos' district office if they wanted to contact her. Hampton
12 went back to his house and called Campos' husband Neil Struthers. Hampton relayed the information to
13 Struthers regarding the two men on Juliet Ave asking for Nora Campos. The two men drove away from the
14 area north on Juliet Ave a few minutes after Hampton made contact with them.
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16 I made contact with Neil Struthers at his residence. He told me that he received a call from his neighbor
17 Darren Hampton that there were two men on the street asking for the location of Nora Campos' house.
18 Struthers walked out of his house and observed a maroon Ford sedan driving north on Juliet Ave toward
19 Rosemar Ave away from the area. Struthers recognized the vehicle as belonging to Laborers Union Local
20 270 and recognized the passenger of the vehicle as Mario Delgado. Struthers identified Mario Delgado as
21 president of Laborers Union Local 270 and told me that he was in a fight with Delgado on April 29, 2016 at
22 function at the Fairmont Hotel downtown San Jose. Struthers told me that he made a telephonic report to
23 San Jose Police Department the day after the incident because he was assaulted by Delgado on April 29th.
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25 CHP Officer J. Morones #19509 arrived on scene and assisted patrolling the area for the Ford Fusion
26 vehicle and the two men that were associated with the vehicle. Officer Morones was unable to locate the
27 vehicle.
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29 Lieutenant Loetscher arrived on scene and I advised him of the situation and that no crime had been
30 committed. Lt. Loetscher contacted the San Jose Police Department patrol Lieutenant Ford and advised of
31 the incident that occurred. Lt. Loetscher requested San Jose Police Department to add this incident to the
32 April 29th incident.
